

WHEREAS, various activities undertaken by the HECap Board constitute "actions" requiring review under SEQRA; and

WHEREAS, the Dormitory Authority, as staff to the HECap Board, undertakes certain functions necessary to comply with SEQRA and the Dormitory Authority's Board has delegated the authority to undertake certain SEQRA-related responsibilities to Jack D. Homkow, Director of Environmental Affairs.

WHEREAS, the HECap Board is desirous of authorizing, Jack D. Homkow, Director of Environmental Affairs for the Dormitory Authority, as staff to the HECap Board, to undertake certain functions as are necessary for complying with SEQRA.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Members of the HECap Board as follows:

1. Jack D. Homkow, Director, Environmental Affairs, is hereby authorized to perform certain functions necessary to comply with SEQRA, including, but not limited to: preparing and/or executing documents required in connection with the HECap Board's participation in the SEQRA process, preparing determinations of significance or non-significance for the HECap Board's approval and performing such other functions as are necessary to comply with SEQRA.
