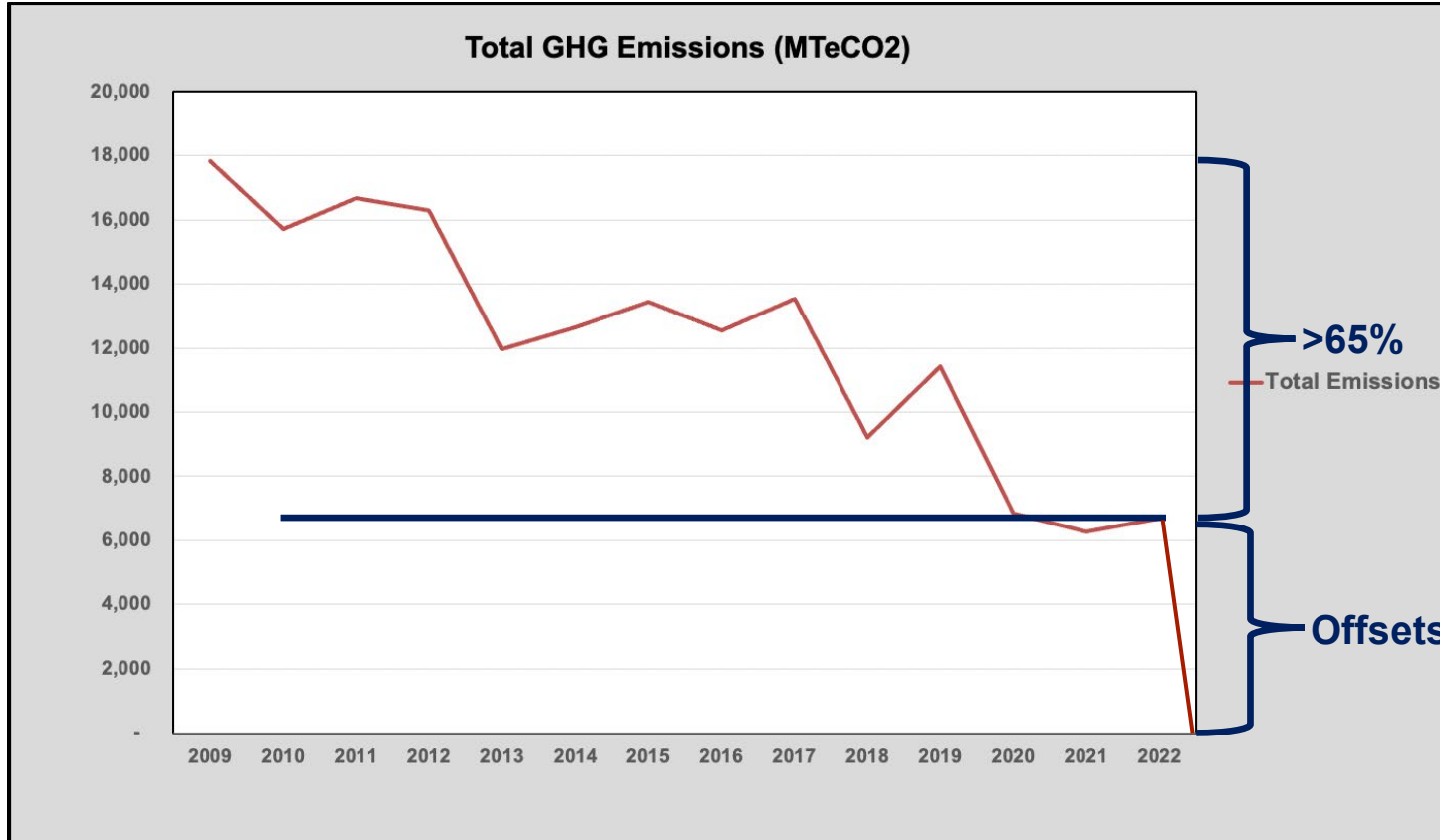

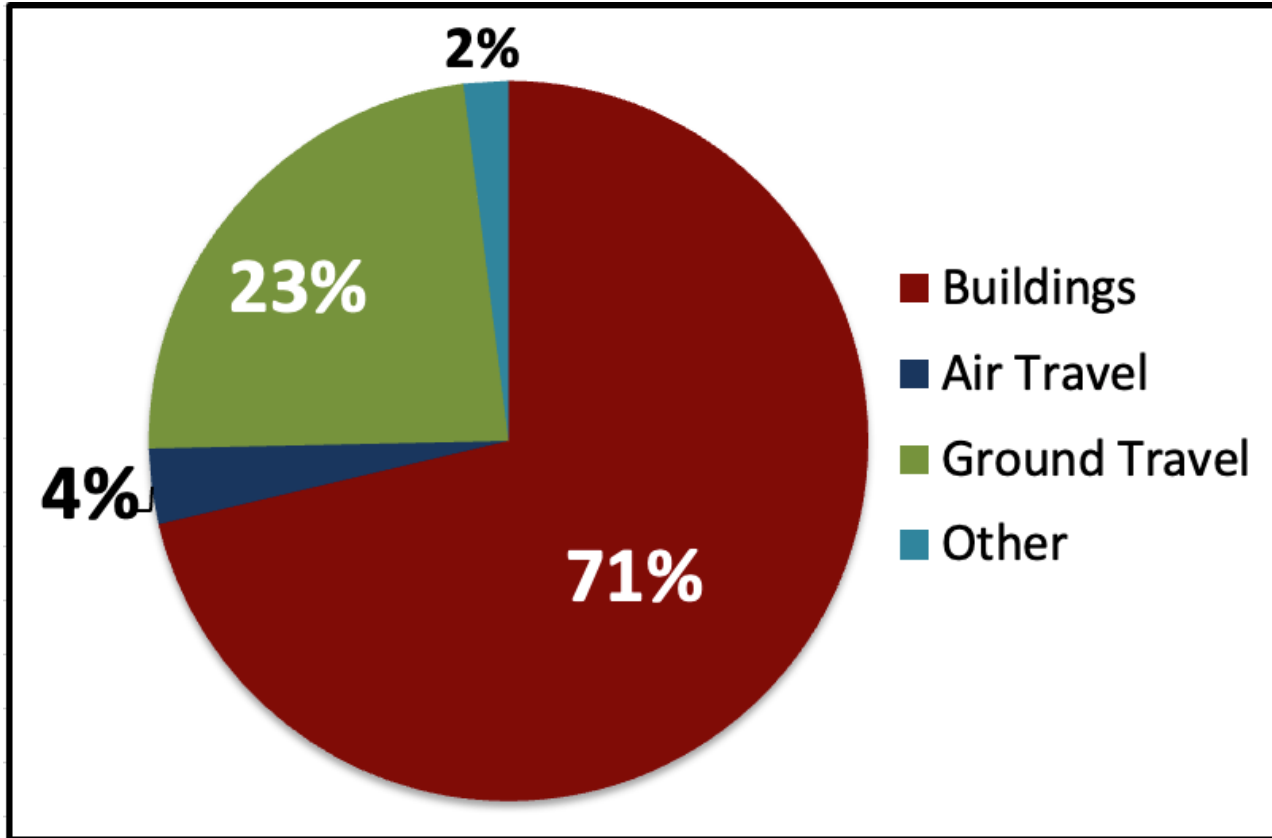
Colgate's GHG emissions

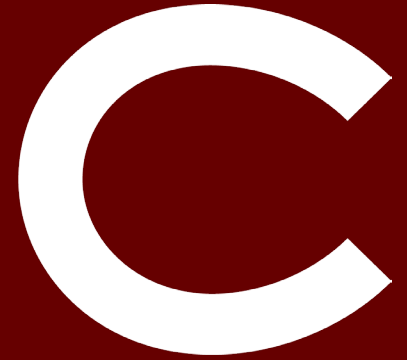
