Minutes of the HECap Board Meeting June 27, 2018

The New York State Higher Education Capital Matching Grant Program ("HECap") Board met by video conference at the Dormitory Authority of the State of New York's Albany Office located at 515 Broadway, Albany, New York and it's New York City Office located at One Penn Plaza, 52nd Floor, New York, New York on June 27, 2018 at 10:30 a.m.

The meeting was called to order by Robert F. Mujica, Chair. The Members present for this meeting were as follows:

Mr. Mujica called the meeting to order and welcomed participants from the Albany and New York City Offices. Mr. Mujica, representative of Governor Cuomo, introduced himself and then asked the members in the NYCO to introduce themselves. Lisa Clare Kombrink, representative to the State Senate, introduced herself. Honorable Deborah Glick, representative to the State Assembly, introduced herself.

Mr. Mujica thanked Ms. Richards as well as the DASNY staff for acting as staff to the Board and asked that she introduce the staff of DASNY. Ms. Richards thanked Mr. Mujica and identified herself as an Associate Counsel in DASNY's Counsels Office. She then introduced staff in the Albany office: Sarah Antonacci, Assistant Director; Deanne DiPace, Senior Grant Administrator and Tim Atkins, Director of Inter-Governmental Relations.

Election of the Chair of the Board and Adoption of Minutes of the November 15, 2017 Meeting

Mr. Mujica stated that the first order of business was to elect a Chair for the HECap Board. Ms. Richards explained to the Members that the resolution before them is a resolution to elect the Chair and that the Chair elected will hold that office until the next annual meeting of the HECap Board or until a successor is elected.

Member Glick made a motion to elect Robert F. Mujica as Chair to the HeCap Board.

Ms. Kombrink seconded the motion and the resolution was unanimously adopted.

The Minutes of the November 15, 2017 Board Meeting were then reviewed and approved by the Members. Mr. Mujica asked if there were any comments or corrections to the minutes, which there were none. Ms. Kombrink made a motion to adopt the minutes, seconded by Assembly Member Glick. Mr. Mujica stated that the minutes were approved.

Mr. Mujica then requested Ms. Richards provide a status update on the previously awarded grants and a summary of the applications received for the second Request for Grant Applications ("RGA"). Ms. Richards stated that there was one Non-Competitive Round of HECap grants previously awarded that are largely wrapped up. She directed the Members to the summary of the Non-Competitive Round, Competitive Round 1 and Competitive Round 2 located the Board Member binder.

Ms. Richards explained that Competitive Round 1 are the grants awarded on February 4, 2016. Ms. Richards acknowledged that twelve (12) of the 29 Institutions awarded in Competitive Round 1 have executed Grant Disbursement Agreements ("GDA") and nine (9) Institutions have been fully paid out. She further noted that three (3) Institutions are currently in the requisition process and five (5) Institutions had withdrawn and will not proceed to the GDA stage. She stated that the remaining grants are still in the review process, which could be a combination of the Environmental Review, Financial Review or a Legal Review to verify compliance with all the statutory parameters.

Ms. Richards noted that the Competitive Round 2 Request for Grant Applications was issued on November 21, 2017. In this process the RGA was amended slightly to try to obtain a broader range of Institutions applying, larger and smaller, as well as reduce the number of scoring categories so that more Institutions would have an opportunity to succeed. She advised the Members that some categories such as Environmental Review were deferred into the actual contract stage making it a requirement to be completed prior to the Grant Disbursement Agreement but not an item that was scored upon.

Ms. Richards further explained that the projects were to be completed between August 1, 2017 and August 1, 2020, and the applications were due by February 9, 2018. She stated that 45 Institutions applied totaling \$70.7 million and were scored by three staff at DASNY who are experienced with the grant program, grant application process and evaluation of a quality grant application. She explained that of the 45 applicants, 39 scored 70 or above (the minimum score to be eligible to receive an award) which are identified in the Board Member binder. She stated the applicants that were not selected were due to project being ineligible or the inability of the Institution to clearly identify how the project met the statutory criteria.

Ms. Richards stated that DASNY was pleased to see so many applicants meeting the minimum score. She noted that the awards are conditional awards for which further reviews would need to be conducted including but not limited to an environmental review, financial review and legal which would include making sure that the Institution is in compliance with the prevailing wage and MWBE requirements for all aspects of the project. Ms. Richards turned the meeting back over to Mr. Mujica.

Mr. Mujica asked if there are any questions for Ms. Richards, which there were none.

Assembly Member Glick made a motion to approve the resolution:

Ms. Kombrink seconded the motion and the resolution was unanimously adopted.

Mr. Mujica asked that Ms. Richards provide a summary of the process for Competitive Round 3 RGA. Ms. Richards thanked Mr. Mujica and stated that before the Board Members for consideration is a draft of the RGA for another round of HECap funding. She explained that this round is largely the same as the last round. Ms. Richards explained that the Resolution before the HECap Board would (1) authorize the draft RGA to be approved, (2) would authorize DASNY, as staff to the Board, to make minor additions or deletions that may be required, including adjustments to the grant funding levels and key dates and (3) allow DASNY to release the RGA for the purpose of soliciting additional proposals for HECap projects to be considered by the HECap Board for grant awards.

Ms. Richards further explained that the Resolution would authorize DASNY to determine the total amount of funds available to be awarded pursuant to the RGA based upon information in DASNY's possession. She stated that the total amount is not expected to exceed \$40 Million, including the residual and the additional appropriation from this year. Ms. Richards turned the meeting back over to Mr. Mujica.

Mr. Mujica asked whether there are any questions on the resolution, which there were none.

Ms. Kombrink made a motion to approve the resolution:

Assembly Member Glick seconded the motion and the resolution was unanimously adopted.

Mr. Mujica noted that this concluded the business before the Board and inquired if there was any new business to be presented to the Board. Hearing none, Mr. Mujica thanked DASNY

staff for their work undertaken to date. He stated that as a result of the meeting a number of very important projects have been funded. He also requested that going forward that every effort is made to expedite the process so that more projects come to fruition.

Ms. Richards stated that DASNY, as staff to the Board, are available to help expedite the process, whether it be webinars, meetings or any other suggestions to help move the projects forward.

Mr. Mujica thanks Ms. Richards and confirmed that as a result of today's meeting DASNY, as staff to the Board, will post the HECap RGA to solicit application for the third competitive round of HECap funding. The HECap Board meeting was adjourned at 10:42a.m.
