

Minutes of HECap Board Meeting November 15, 2017

The New York State Higher Education Capital Matching Grant Program ("HECap") Board met by video conference at the Dormitory Authority of the State of New York's Albany office located at 515 Broadway, Albany, New York and its New York City Office located at One Penn Plaza, 52nd Floor, New York, New York on November 15, 2017 at 3:00 p.m.

The meeting was called to order by Robert F. Mujica, Chair. The Members present for this meeting were as follows:

Mr. Mujica called the meeting to order and welcomed participants from the Albany and New York City offices. Mr. Mujica introduced Sara Richards, Associate General Counsel of DASNY. He noted that DASNY serves as staff to the HECap Board in connection with the HECap program.

Ms. Richards thanked Mr. Mujica and introduced Ms. Margaret Ambrose, Assistant Director; Ms. Sarah D. Antonacci, Senior Grant Administrator; Ms. Deanne DiPace, Grant Administrator and Ms. Debra Drescher, Managing General Counsel.

Election of the Chair of the Board and Adoption of Minutes of the February 4, 2016 Meeting

Mr. Mujica stated that the first order of business was to elect a Chair for the HECap Board. Assemblymember Glick made a motion to elect Robert F. Mujica as the Chair of the HECap Board:

Ms. Kombrink seconded the motion and the resolution was unanimously adopted.

The Minutes of the February 4, 2016 Board Meeting were then reviewed and approved by the Members. Mr. Mujica asked if there were any comments or corrections to the minutes, which there were none. Assembly Member Glick made a motion to adopt the minutes, seconded by Ms. Kombrink. Mr. Mujica stated that the minutes were approved.

Mr. Mujica asked that Ms. Richards provide a status update on previously awarded grants and the second Request for Grant Applications ("RGA"). Ms. Richards explained that the final amount available for grant awards will be determined based upon the funds available on the due date for the Grant Applications, and will be a combination of prior year appropriations and funds remaining from grants not fully paid out.

Ms. Richards stated that the Resolution before the Members for approval would (1) approve the new draft of the RGA; (2) authorize an Authorized Officer of DASNY, acting as staff to the HECap Board, to make minor changes that may be necessary to finalize the document; and (3) to release the RGA for purposes of soliciting proposals for the HECap projects to be considered by the Board.

Ms. Richards further explained that the Resolution also authorizes DASNY staff to determine the total amount of funds available to be awarded pursuant to the RGA, based upon information available to DASNY.

Ms. Richards explained that in recent months, DASNY staff has been working with the members' respective staffs to draft a new Request for Grant Applications (RGA). The draft RGA and Grant Application has been simplified by reducing the number of scoring categories in order to encourage participation and focus the scoring points on critical project elements. She stated that the Grant Funding Levels were also modified to try to encourage a wider range of projects and be more accessible to smaller schools. Ms. Richards turned the meeting back over to Mr. Mujica.

Mr. Mujica asked for clarification on the changes to the size of the minimum and maximum grant awards. Ms. Richards explained that the new RGA lowered the minimum threshold to reach the smaller colleges that may not have as many resources available to meet the 3:1 match requirement. The minimum grant award was lowered to \$50,000 and the maximum grant award was increased to \$5 Million, to allow all colleges and universities the ability to find a grant that meets their needs within that range. Other Grant funding levels were modified accordingly. Ms. Richards explained that the amount of the grant will depend on the cost of the project to be funded with the HECap grant such that larger projects will be eligible for larger grants. She noted that the larger the grant, the larger the match requirement. She stated that the Base Pool concept has remained the same: once all of the grants out of each level are funded and the available amount of funds are used up in each scoring band, the remainder is awarded to the next highest scoring Applications in order, regardless of grant amount. She noted that in the last round, this approach helped to fund the highest scoring projects overall.

Ms. Richards further explained that the number of scoring categories was reduced to three: (1) the completeness of the Application (10 points); (2) project description; (50 points); and (3) financial review (40 points). She stated that these categories are designed to enable reviewers to better focus on quality projects for which committed funding sources are available. In response to a question from Mr. Mujica, Ms. Richards stated that the two categories that were scored the first round, but that are proposed to be eliminated from this round for scoring purposes are (1) environmental review and (2) site control. Ms. Richards informed the Board Members that although DASNY will verify that all appropriate environmental and real property reviews are completed prior to entering into a Grant Disbursement Agreement with the Grantee, these categories will not be graded as part of the evaluation process. She explained that these sections appeared to be confusing to the applicants and in some cases resulted in incomplete information being communicated to DASNY. Ms. Richards stated that in order to avoid confusion, maximize participation, and focus on the quality and impact of the projects being proposed, it was determined that the points previously allocated to these two categories should be absorbed by the project description and financial review categories.

In response to a question from Assemblymember Glick, Ms. Richards explained that DASNY will still conduct an environmental review pursuant to SEQRA, as well as the Historic Preservation Law, Smart Growth Act, and other applicable environmental laws. She further explained that the level of reviews would be the same and that there will be no diminution in the level of scrutiny utilized in connection with the reviews. Ms. Richards emphasized that the only difference between this round and the round previously awarded is that the applications would not be scored based upon where they are in the environmental review process. She assured the Members that DASNY would continue to verify that all required environmental laws and regulations are complied with.

Assemblymember Glick expressed her view that colleges and universities should expand their facilities in cooperation with the communities in which they are located. She stated that she has fielded calls in the past from other elected officials regarding the site selection processes utilized by certain potential applicants. Ms. Richards stated that if there are particular concerns that DASNY should be made aware of in connection with a particular project or the environmental review process, she encouraged the person with concerns to contact DASNY or the lead agency directly.

Ms. Richards stated that additional language has been added to the RGA to further underscore the statutory requirement to comply with prevailing wage and MWBE requirements. She further stated that despite this requirement being set forth in the statute, RGA, and GDA, many Grantees have not understood that compliance is mandatory and that DASNY cannot waive this requirement. Ms. Richards informed the Members that the RGA also makes clear that grants awarded under the State and Municipal Facilities grant program cannot be used as match funds to HECap grants pursuant to the SAM enabling legislation.

Ms. Richards stated that the other provisions of the RGA are substantively similar to the prior versions.

Mr. Mujica thanked Ms. Richards and asked whether there are any questions on the resolution, which there were none.

Assemblymember Glick made a motion to approve the resolution:

MATCHING (HECap) GRANT PROGRAM BOARD APPROVING THE HECap REQUEST
FOR GRANT APPLICATIONS FOR COMPETITIVE ROUND 2

Ms. Kombrink seconded the motion and the resolution was unanimously adopted.

Mr. Mujica noted that this concluded the new business before the Board and inquired if there was any new business to be presented to the Board. Hearing none, Mr. Mujica thanked the DASNY staff for their work undertaken to date. He confirmed that, as a result of today's meeting, DASNY, as staff to the Board, will post the HECap RGA to solicit applications for the second competitive round of HECap funding. The HECap Board Meeting was adjourned at 3:20 p.m.
