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Minutes of the HECap Board Meeting July 30, 2019

The New York State Higher Education Capital Matching Grant Program ("HECap") Board met by video conference at the Dormitory Authority of the State of New York's ("DASNY") Albany Office located at 515 Broadway, Albany, New York and DASNY's New York City Office located at One Penn Plaza, 52nd Floor, New York, New York on July 30, 2019 at 10:00 a.m.

The meeting was called to order by Robert F. Mujica, Chair. The Members present for this meeting were as follows:

Mr. Mujica called the meeting to order and welcomed participants from the Albany and New York City Offices.

NOTE: The 7/30/19 recording starts just after the introduction of the HECap Board Members (Robert J. Mujica – Member on the behalf of the Executive, Assembly Member Deborah Glick – Member on behalf of the Assembly and Lisa Clare Kombrink-Member on behalf of the Senate) as well as the introduction of DASNY Staff (DASNY's Albany Office: Sara Richards, Esq. – Associate General Counsel; Deanne DiPace – Senior Grant Administrator and in the DASNY NYC Office: Karen Hunter – Director of Grants Administration; Sarah Antonacci – Assistant Director of Grants Administration).

Election of the Chair of the Board and Adoption of Minutes of the June 27, 2018 Meeting

Mr. Mujica stated that the first order of business was to elect a Chair for the HECap Board.

Lisa Clare Kombrink made a motion to elect Robert F. Mujica as Chair to the HECap Board. Assembly Member Glick seconded the motion and the following entitled resolution was unanimously adopted.

A RESOLUTION OF THE NEW YORK STATE HIGHER EDUCATION CAPITAL MATCHING (HECap) GRANT PROGRAM BOARD ELECTING THE CHAIR

The Minutes of the June 27, 2018 Board Meeting were then reviewed and approved by the Members. Assembly Member Glick made a motion to adopt the minutes, seconded by Lisa Clare Kombrink. The minutes were unanimously approved.

Mr. Mujica asked Ms. Richards to provide a status update on the previously awarded grants and a summary of the applications received in response to the third Request for Grant Applications ("RGA"). Ms. Richards summarized the preceding rounds of funding. She said that Competitive Round 1 Grants were awarded on February 4, 2016 for projects to be completed between April 1, 2014 and March 31, 2017, and that fifteen (15) of the twenty-nine (29) Institutions awarded in Competitive Round 1 have executed Grant Disbursement Agreements ("GDAs") totaling \$15.9 million. Ms. Richards further stated that fourteen (14) Institutions have been paid the full amount of their grant.

Ms. Richards informed the Members that the Board awarded grants in connection with the Competitive Round 2 RGA on June 27, 2018 for projects to be completed between August 1, 2017 and August 1, 2020. In this round, thirty-nine (39) Institutions were awarded grants and are all in the review process.

Ms. Richards stated that the Competitive Round 3 RGA was issued on October 31, 2018 for projects to be completed between August 1, 2018 and August 1, 2021. She explained that applications were due on February 8, 2019 and that forty-one (41) Institutions had applied for grant funds totaling \$26.3 million. Ms. Richards stated that the same scoring criteria used in prior rounds was used to score the applications. She informed the Members that thirty-six (36) applicants received the required minimum score, and that one of these applicants subsequently withdrew its application. Therefore, today the Board is being asked to approve 35 HECap Grant awards totaling \$21.3 million.

Mr. Mujica thanked Ms. Richards and asked the Members if they had any questions.

Ms. Kombrink moved the adoption of the following entitled Resolution:

A RESOLUTION OF THE NEW YORK STATE HIGHER EDUCATION CAPITAL MATCHING GRANT PROGRAM (HECap) BOARD AWARDING HECAP GRANTS

Assembly Member Glick seconded the motion and the resolution was unanimously adopted.

Mr. Mujica asked Ms. Richards to provide a summary of the process for the upcoming Competitive Round 4. Ms. Richards thanked Mr. Mujica and stated that before the Board Members for consideration is a draft of the RGA for another round of HECap funding. She explained that this RGA is substantially the same as prior rounds with some adjustments to try to meet a broader range of Institutions (large and small). Ms. Richards further explained that the grant funding levels will be modified, and the top award will be \$5 million. Ms. Richards stated that DASNY will host several webinars to explain the application process and provide helpful advice on how to effectively apply for a HECap grant award. Ms. Richards noted that it is currently expected that the RGA will award funding for projects that will begin in August 2019. She stated that if approved, the RGA could be released this fall and awards could be made at the beginning of the new year.

Mr. Mujica inquired about the total amount of funds available during this round. Ms. Richards responded that the total amount is not expected to exceed \$65 million, including the residual funds left over from prior rounds and the additional appropriation from this year.

Assembly Member Glick asked about the level of participation on the webinars. She observed that a number of Institutions have withdrawn due to the prevailing wage requirement. Ms. Richards responded that webinar attendance has been fairly good, however, the private Institutions are not accustomed to paying prevailing wage and do not understand that they need to be in compliance with these provisions. She informed the Members that this requirement will be emphasized in future webinars.

Mr. Mujica asked if any of the Institutions have withdrawn or have decided not to compete because of the prevailing wage requirement, and if so, whether the requirement impacts all areas of the State equally. Ms. Richards stated that some Institutions have pointed to the prevailing wage requirement as a reason for withdrawal from the HECap program. She further stated that Institutions throughout the State have been impacted, although it tends to affect the upstate Institutions to a greater degree.

Mr. Mujica inquired about the rationale for adjusting the grant award amounts and grant funding levels. Ms. Richards replied that there are significantly more funds available in this round and past experience has shown that there are typically more applications for larger projects. She stated that larger grant amounts will fill this need while utilizing available funds.

Mr. Mujica asked whether there were any additional questions for Ms. Richards, which there were none.

Assembly Member Glick moved the adoption of the following entitled Resolution:

A RESOLUTION OF THE NEW YORK STATE HIGHER EDUCATION CAPITAL MATCHING (HECap) GRANT PROGRAM BOARD APPROVING THE HECap REQUEST FOR GRANT APPICATIONS FOR COMPETITIVE ROUND 4

Ms. Kombrink seconded the motion and the resolution was unanimously adopted.

Mr. Mujica noted that this concluded the business before the Board and inquired if there was any new business to be presented to the Board. Hearing none, Mr. Mujica thanked DASNY staff for their work undertaken to date. He noted that as a result of today's meeting DASNY, as staff to the Board, will post the HECap RGA to solicit application for the fourth competitive round of HECap funding in the near future. The HECap Board meeting was adjourned at 10:11 a.m.
