

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED PROJECTS AND ISSUANCE OF
STATE SALES TAX REVENUE BONDS AND/OR
STATE PERSONAL INCOME TAX REVENUE BONDS (GENERAL PURPOSE)
BY THE DORMITORY AUTHORITY OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK**

Public notice is hereby given that, at the time and place designated below, the Dormitory Authority of the State of New York (“**DASNY**”) will conduct a public hearing for the purpose of giving interested persons an opportunity to be heard on the projects described below, each of which is located within the State of New York (collectively, the “**Projects**”), and the proposed issuance by DASNY pursuant to a plan of finance of one or more series at one or more times of tax-exempt Dormitory Authority of the State of New York State Personal Income Tax Revenue Bonds and/or tax-exempt Dormitory Authority of the State of New York State Sales Tax Revenue Bonds in a combined aggregate principal amount not to exceed **\$19,000,000** (collectively, the “**Bonds**”). The public is invited to comment either in person or in writing with respect to the Projects and the issuance of the Bonds.

Proceeds of the Bonds are expected to be used, together with other available monies to, among other purposes: (i) finance, or refund bonds the proceeds of which were used to finance or refinance, the cost of acquiring, constructing, furnishing, equipping, renovating or otherwise providing the Projects at the locations and in the estimated amounts and initially owned, operated and/or managed by the entities set forth below; and (ii) pay a portion of the costs of issuance of the Bonds. The Projects are administered by the New York State Office of Mental Health (“**OMH**”) and the New York State Office of Addiction Services and Supports (“**OASAS**”) on behalf of the not for profit corporations identified below.

A public hearing with respect to the proposed issuance of the Bonds will be held at 10:00 a.m. on March 2, 2021. In light of the COVID-19 public health crisis, such public hearing is being conducted remotely, through the use of telephone conference. Interested persons are invited to listen to, and participate in, the public hearing by calling into the teleconference using the toll-free-number (866) 394-2346 and entering conference code 3592186282#. In order to facilitate registration of participants to the teleconference, it is requested that such persons call the above number no later than 9:55 a.m. Written comments can be submitted to DASNY via email at damodio@dasny.org no later than 10:30 a.m. on the date of the public hearing. All or a portion of the Projects will be financed from proceeds of the portion of the Bonds to be issued pursuant to Section 145 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the “**Code**”) and consist of the following facilities:

OASAS-C-001552: Samaritan Daytop Village, Inc. will finance or refinance the acquisition, construction and/or rehabilitation of building(s) used as chemical dependency treatment facilities. The project consists of approximately 18,600 square feet located at 130-15 89th Road, Richmond Hill, Queens County, with a total project cost to be refinanced estimated not to exceed **\$8,820,900**.

OASAS-C-001862: The Lower East Side Service Center, Inc. will finance or refinance the

acquisition, construction and/or rehabilitation of building(s) used as chemical dependency treatment facilities. The project consists of approximately 50,200 square feet located at 7 Gouverneur Slip East, New York, New York County, with a total project cost to be refinanced estimated not to exceed **\$7,431,400**.

OASAS-C-002154: Liberty Resources, Inc. will finance or refinance the acquisition, construction and/or rehabilitation of building(s) used as chemical dependency treatment facilities. The project consists of approximately 18,065 square feet located at 1045 James Street, Syracuse, Onondaga County, with a total project cost to be refinanced estimated not to exceed **\$1,046,800**.

OMH-C-00255GG: SCO Family of Services will finance or refinance the acquisition, construction and/or rehabilitation of building(s) used as a community residence providing services for children and youth with varying degrees of mental illness. The project consists of approximately 6,540 square feet and 9 beds located at 218-41 99th Avenue, Queens Village, Queens County, with a total project cost to be refinanced estimated not to exceed **\$1,175,700**.

OMH-C-000163: Options For Community Living, Inc. will finance or refinance the acquisition, construction and/or rehabilitation of building(s) used as a residential facility providing services for persons with varying degrees of mental illness. The project consists of approximately 5,111 square feet and 12 beds located at 470 Richmond Boulevard, Ronkonkoma, Suffolk County, with a total project cost to be refinanced estimated not to exceed **\$461,500**.
