#### Project Manual:

#### 1. Information for Bidders Section 10.0 Minimum and Maximum Contract Values and Bid Security, D: Revised to state:

Only the apparent Low Bidders *must* provide a letter from their Surety attesting to their overall and per project bonding limits. Bidders *are not* required to submit a letter from their Surety with their bids.

**Question and Answer Summary:** Below is a summary of questions DASNY received by the April 6, 2021 due date for the submission of questions pertaining to this JOC contract solicitation and DASNY's response the questions submitted.

#### 1. Do pages 7 through 44 in Volume 1 of the bid documents include all the required bid submission items?

Please review the Construction Bid Requirements section of each JOC contract solicitation carefully and ensure that you comply with all requirements contained therein.

#### 2. Can I obtain a list of bidders with their contact information?

A list of attendees at the March 22, 2021 Pre-Bid meeting is posted to DASNY's website; [www.DASNY.org](http://www.DASNY.org); please refer to the "Attachments" section.

#### 3. Do we need to provide either a deposit or proof of bonding when submitting a bid?

A Bid Bond is required. Please refer to the ad posted to DASNY's website for this solicitation. Only the apparent low bidder for each contract must provide a letter from their surety to evidence their per project and aggregate bonding limits. By submitting a bid, bidders attest that they have bonding capacity at least equal to the value of the contract for which a bid is submitted.

#### 4. Can I bid on both JOC Contract solicitations, i.e. the Open Market contract solicitation and the Small Business Pilot Program contract solicitation?

Firms that qualify to bid under DASNY's Small Business Pilot Program may also bid on the Open Market contract solicitation.
